Home-, sleep-, travel-, youth and children-blankets and living coats made of cotton, nature hair ( wool, uni or yarn dyed in nature, beige, brown, camel, anthracite ), viscose, polyester, polyacrylic and their blends, partly with brand fibres made of acrylic (Amicor, Dralon, Dolan, Didalon), viscose (smartfiber-smartcel sensitive), polyester (Trevira CS), metallized polyester fibres or added with x-threads polyamide (X-Static), dyed, yarndyed and printed, partly produced with fibres accepted by Oeko-Tex® having biological active or flame retardant properties, as well as polyester fur imitate blankets and cushion (art. Brillant in black, art. Trend in grey, brown), cushion made of 100% polyester, flat, embroidered, buckskin optic, uni dyed and/or printed, inside cushion made of polypropylene, filling made of polyester hollow fibre, incl. accessories (zipper, sewing and embroidery thread, pressbutton, edge tape, pailletten, label), produced by using Oeko-Tex® certified materials.

The results of the inspection made according to Oeko-Tex® Standard 100, **product class II** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the standard presently established for products with direct contact to skin.

The certified articles fulfil the requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo-dyes, nickel, etc.) as well as the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the Oeko-Tex® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested.
